MEETING IN HUNGARY

After the first meeting, in November 2009 in Italy, with the schools of Capannoli, Pontedera and Volterra that hosted Hungarian, Turkish, Polish and German schools involved in the project, from 5th to 10th of May 2010, the second meeting among the partners of the project took place in Hungary, to be more precise in the little city of Diozd. The meeting was set up in the local primary and secondary school and our delegation was composed by 11 students (of the classes 1CG, 2BG and 3CG) and 3 teachers. The hospitality was excellent and the organization splendid, ended with a delicious medieval dinner, delighted with music and cheered up with plays of arms and archery.

During the days spent in Diozd, each school had presented its own works about the House in the Past according to its own point of view, because in this project there are schools of all types and grades, and of different orientations. It had been very educational to see how every single school in its own country had analyzed the subject and what was the product that all together could appreciate.

Students had been actors and performers of all the works. In particular, they were divided in mixed groups, composed by students and teachers from the different countries, and they had the chance to visit some characteristic houses of the city, to interview their inhabitants and, consequently, to carry out some power point works that enclosed their experience as interviewer and researcher to go deeply into the topic of the project: the house.

The meeting also included a sightseeing tour to Budapest, where it was possible to see the different architectural styles of the city and some excursions to a XVII century rural village, that was almost unchanged and for this reason used as an at-open-air museum, where all the participants could admire the atmosphere of the rural life of the past ages.
